Alexa Mairhofer (*1995 in Brixen/IT) completed her Master's degree with honours in Renaissance and Baroque singing at the Giuseppe Verdi Conservatory in Milan with Prof. Gemma Bertagnolli. She previously completed a teacher training program in the subjects of school music and theology, as well as instrumental music education with the artistic main subjects of singing and choral conducting at the Mozarteum Salzburg.

As a singer in the Audi Jugend Chor Academy under the conducting of Martin Steidler, she has performed with renowned ensembles such as the Academy for Early Music, the Helsinki Baroque Orchestra and the Hamburg State Orchestra. Collaborations with conductors such as Kent Nagano and Aapo Häkkinen have taken her to internationally renowned concert halls, including Carnegie Hall in New York, the Elbphilharmonie in Hamburg, the Musiikkitalo in Helsinki, the Philharmonie Berlin, the Isarphilharmonie and the Gasteig in Munich. In addition to her work as a soloist, ensemble singer and choir director, she teaches singing and piano in Bruneck.
