National radio broadcasts by BR, WDR or MDR and sponsorship from the Steinwayhaus München, the Bundesapothekerkammer, the Versicherungskammer Bayern or the award of the Kulturförderpreis des Landkreises Freising have also demonstrated her musical finesse and supported her in her career.
